Rob Southwick presented on Data Dashboards:

- Up and working now
- Rob did a demo of the dashboard
 - Actual sales of licenses
 - Currently 10 states in the dashboard
 - Need states to participate and provide data through the license vendors
 - Grant now provides help with cost, so there is essentially no cost to participate
 - Will provide code for security (filter out SSN, etc.)

Brad Bortner – Wildlife Management Institute

- USFWS gets names and addresses from every state. Ask the hunters directly.
- Third part data entry is problematic. Clerks at the store don't want to enter the data, which messes up the stratification
- Want hunters to call into a number to report their data
- Trying to identify states and find solutions to the problems. Takes one month for USFWS to send data to the hunter, so the hunter has to remember harvest numbers all the way back a month
- Want to develop open source module on collecting HIPP data
