### What Else Do We Know?


- 2 million traded over 20 yrs<sup>1</sup>
  - •~93% = Testudinidae, Geoemydidae,
- Emydidae, and Trionychidae
- US is important in turtle trade
  - 23% exports
  - 16% imports
- Data is incomplete/ inconsistent





What Else Do We Know?


- Patchwork of regulations
