Logo Usage Guidelines	The BearWise logo is your guarantee that any materials it appears on are consistent with the BearWise mission and message and have been approved by the committee.			
Download BearWise Logo Package	Member states may use the logo on promotional items and other items used by agency personnel. Use of the BearWise logo on any state-created educational materials or items meant to be sold requires prior review and approval.			
Monitor and enforce BearWise logo and messaging by others in your state	Many parks and forests, other agencies, NGOs and businesses want to include BearWise information or list the BearWise Basics in their materials. The BearWise state rep and committee needs to review and approve the use of BearWise information and logo.			
Send bear photos	We always need photos for the website, eblasts, social media and BearWise materials. We are happy to give photo credit and thanks to photographers who donate their work. Ask LaVonne to send you a custom link for uploading photos.			
Media Interviews	Any state-specific requests will be forwarded to the state media contact you provide when you complete the questionnaire.  Requests that are national in scope will be forwarded to the Chair.
